

Protocols for participating in Live Worship

Please note these protocols are subject to change as the pandemic progresses.

- When you arrive in the parking lot, **please bring your facial covering, pre-printed e-ticket**, and pre-printed digital bulletin with you into the Main Church entrance.
- Please **put your facial covering on** and keep your facial covering on throughout the entire service. If you do not bring your own facial covering, we have facial coverings available for you at the Welcome Center.
- As you choose to socialize at church, please do so *outside* before and/or after services. Please do not socialize inside in the lobby. (Ventilation is best outdoors).
- Please **practice social distancing** throughout your church visit.
- As you enter the lobby, you will be met by greeters. Please ensure that you **sanitize your hands** thoroughly at one of the hand sanitizer stations.
- To keep things as touchless as possible, there will be no coffee, water nor cookies served. Please bring your own personal beverages to consume as needed.
- As you approach the sanctuary, an **usher will greet you and seat you**. No bulletins will be handed out by the ushers (please bring your pre-printed bulletin). Households will be sat together with a 6-foot (3-chair) gap between households in the same row. Every other row of chairs in the sanctuary has been removed to provide 6-foot distances between rows. No congregants will be seated in the front row.
- When the worship service has concluded, the **ushers will dismiss** the congregants row by row from the back. Please follow the ushers instructions.
- We have planned a touch-free service. As you exit the sanctuary, there will be a **basket available to place offertory gifts** as desired.
- As you **exit** the sanctuary, you will be directed **down the hallway** and outside by the West doors by the fishbowl. Feel free to stop to use the restrooms as necessary but please leave the building as soon as you can and do not linger inside the building.
