IFMA's Facility Management Professional (FMP) designation is a knowledge-based credential for FM professionals and industry suppliers looking to increase their depth-of-knowledge in the core FM topics deemed critical by employers. By earning the FMP credential, you will improve your knowledge, enhance your skills, and gain immediate credibility with employers, clients, and peers. The FMP Credential provide a strong foundation of the core competencies of Facility Management. There are 4 modules that make up the FMP credential class: Leadership and Strategy, Finance and Business, Project Management and Maintenance and Operation.

The Virtual FMP course is designed to provide students with high level content and review of material, with an opportunity for students to engage, ask questions, and participate in activities in support of preparing for the assessments. This model depends on students preparing for class by reading the assigned chapters in advance of the live sessions. The class will also encourage students to submit questions in advance of class. This course is perfect for motivated learners who want support from an instructor in a virtual classroom setting.

Course Dates & Details:

The course will run 14 weeks, starting with the Course Introduction on Wednesday, January 6th and finishing on April 7th. Class time will be 9am to 12pm and will be held via Zoom. *If the class requires some flexibility in scheduling this can be discussed in the first class.*
